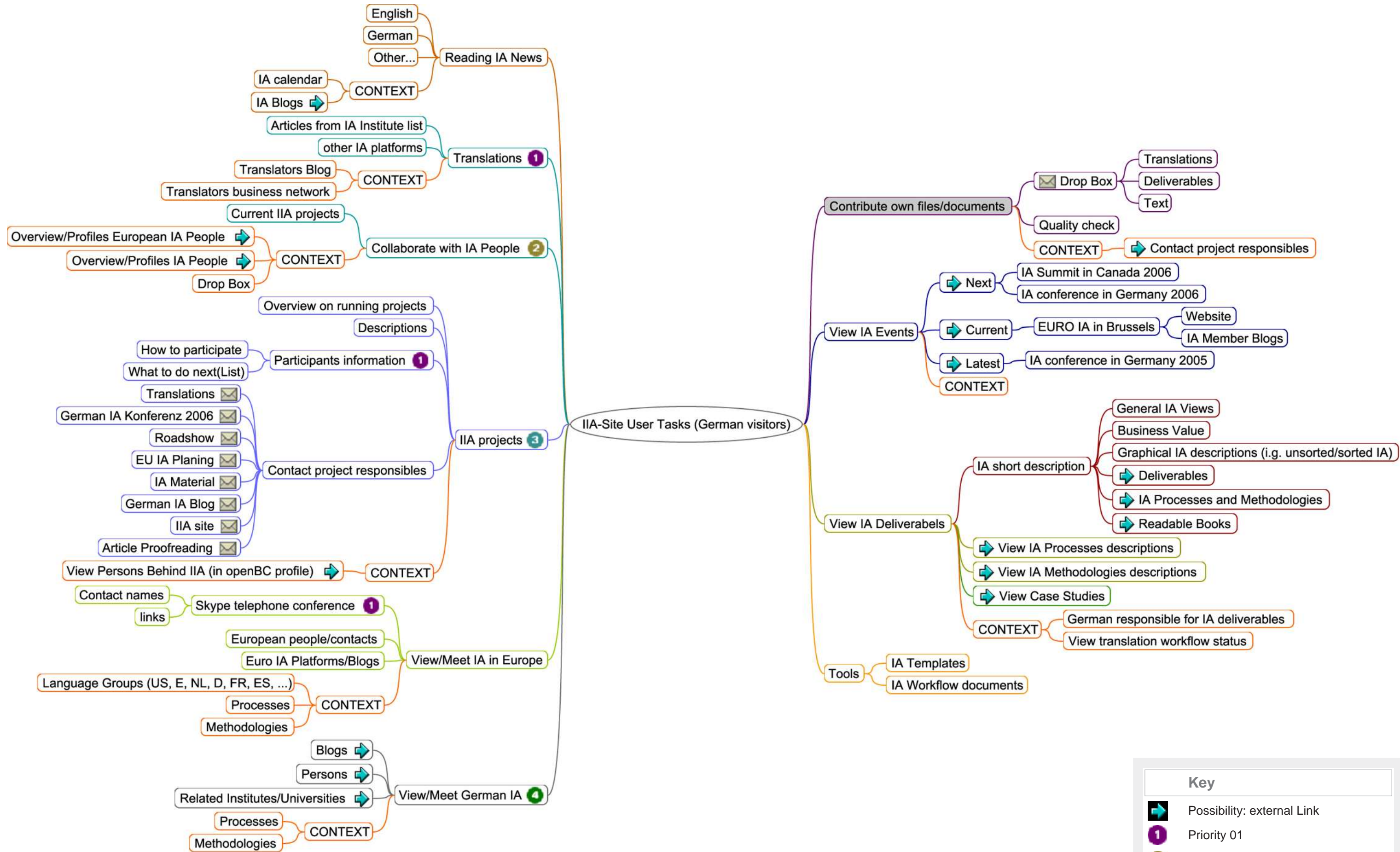

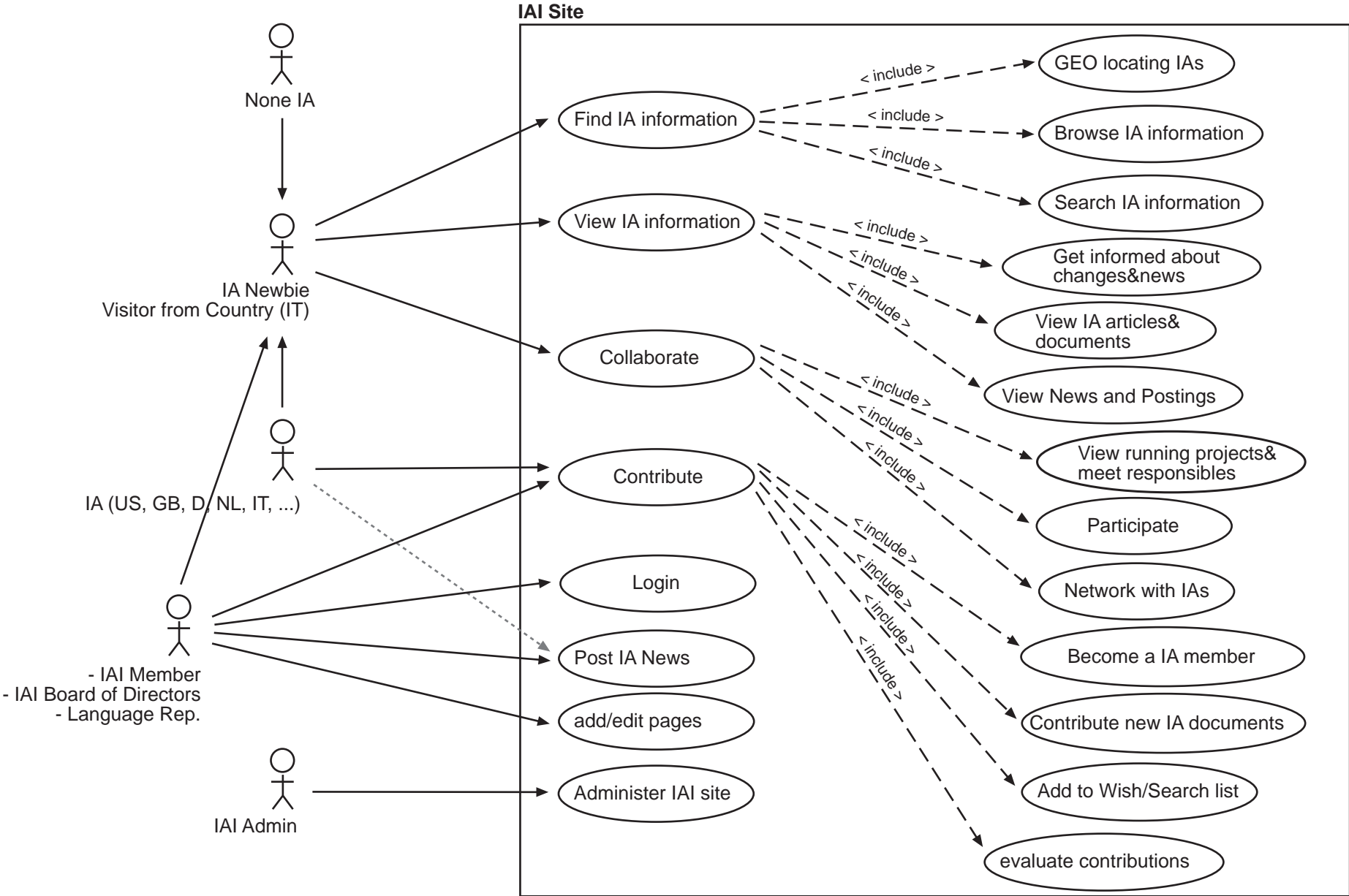

Receiving new information via RSS in a push channel will be interesting for IAs at some places on the site

Strong leverage: One of the IAs main goals should be to "support the networking" of IAs. Therefore the different "discussion channels" should be transparent to the audience. Where is being what topic discussed...?

E.g. "GEO locate IAs" has strong leverage since it is relevant for local groups, running IA projects, Networking IAs, and in the Membership context

Relations between contents will be made visible in the content (view wireframes) in the right side context box called "related to...".

All Entry Pages need to be of a strong explanation character for users best understanding, what that information block(underneath) is doing for them.
